**Vitamin A** is a generic term that refers to fat-soluble compounds found as preformed vitamin A. Retinol can be converted by the body to retinal, which can be in turn be oxidized to retinoic acid, the form of vitamin A known to regulate gene transcription.

**Vitamin A** is critical for vision as an essential component of rhodopsin, a protein that absorbs light in the retinal receptors, and because it supports the normal differentiation and functioning of the conjunctival membranes and cornea. Vitamin A is involved in immune function, vision, reproduction, and cellular communication. Vitamin A also supports cell growth and differentiation, playing a critical role in the normal functioning and maintenance of the heart, lungs, kidneys, and other organs.

**Vitamin A** has important roles in embryonic development, organ formation during fetal development, normal immune functions, and eye development and vision.
